	1. Overall Length	*NOTE: It is IMPERATIVE that the provided
ft. / in.	Stand at the top of your stairs, extend your tape measure until it is laying on all the stair treads and the tip of the tape measure is touching the landing at the bottom of the steps. Record this measurement.	measurements are as precise as possible. 	2. Top Stair to Bottom Stair	will need to be scheduled.
ft. / in.	While still at the top of the stairs, retract the tape measure until the end of the tape is even with the outer-most portion of the stair nose of the bottom step. Record this measurement.	
	3. Staircase Width	_
ft. / in.	Measure the width of your staircase and enter the measurement.	
	4. Bottom Clearance	
ft. / in.	If there is a wall or a door at the bottom of the steps, measure from the bottom step to the wall.	
	5. Rise of One Step	
ft. / in.	Measure from the top of a step to the very next step down.	
	6. Tread Depth	
ft. / in.	Measure from the front of one step to the front of the kickplate.	
	7. Diagonal	
ft. / in.	Measure from the front of one step to the front of the next step down.	
	8. Top Clearance	
ft. / in.	Measure from the top step to the door, wall, or other obstruction at the top of the stairs.
